

Submission Guidelines

The Washington Art Association & Gallery accepts submissions on a rolling basis throughout the year and in all media: painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture, photography, digital art and mixed media. You may submit your artwork as a “general submission.” All artwork submitted is reviewed by our Exhibition Committee and kept on file to be considered for upcoming exhibitions. If your work fits a particular exhibition you will be notified directly by the Washington Art Association & Gallery.

Artists should submit a CV, an artist statement, artist bio and three images in JPG (300dpi) form. Work submitted without all of this information will not be considered.

The following guidelines will apply to your accepted submission:

- The Washington Art Association & Gallery will deduct and retain a commission of 40% on all sales made or contracted for during the show, and resulting from contacts made at the show.
- WAA arranges for the design of an e-card, which we send to our extensive mailing list, and which we will also forward to you for your use. There will be an opening with drinks and hors d’oeuvres provided by WAA.
- The Washington Art Association & Gallery will hang the show at the curator’s discretion. Please make sure that your work is ready for hanging with wires for paintings and framed works. Any work received not ready to hang will not be hung.

- Work will be insured only while on exhibition at the gallery. WAA will take every possible care in handling work, but is not responsible for any loss or damage to pieces not picked up promptly when the show comes down. If you choose to mail us your work, please insure your property both to and from our gallery, as well as provide us with proper prepaid return shipping label.
